March 2024 Adjustments to Sunday Meeting Schedules

Dear Brothers and Sisters:

With approval of the Stake Presidency, beginning next Sunday, March 10, 2024, several wards in the stake will implement combined youth and primary programs. The purpose of this change is to provide a more fulfilling experience for youth and primary children in the respective wards' efforts to help youth and children come unto Christ. As part of the changes, the wards will meet separately for sacrament meeting but will combine youth and primary classes during the 2nd hour blocks.

The wards implementing these changes include Moran Prairie and 1st wards at the Regal Building, and Manito and 2nd wards at the Stake Center. The arrangements will be somewhat similar to the existing combined youth and primary programs in the Lincoln Heights Ward and Regal Branch. The wards now implementing these changes will have youth and primary leaders called from each ward to support classes and quorums that are similarly blended in their class and quorum presidencies. Generally, each ward will continue to meet separately for adult classes and quorum meetings.


